It is important to understand that volunteering to do a job and doing it are two different things. As a person who has run numerous organizations, a volunteer in name without the work is worse than an open spot. Once you volunteer, you need to follow through with what you said you would do. Second, a National Specialty is a complex task where all activities intertwine and involve cooperation. Hospitality is involved in all sorts of activities. Grounds work involves making sure that facilities and movement of people is smooth and under control. Any "event" like a Hunt Test requires hospitality for lunches and other aspects, volunteers to coordinate parking, signage for participants and spectators, volunteers to help run the event, raffles and trophies/ ribbons and many other items. We have all participated in a single event at some time. Helped run a WC/X test, specialty show or other activities. Just multiply that by 100 times to get how much is involved.

So, in addition to club members, we are recruiting people from other clubs and friends of all sorts. You can be part of this by helping with a committee, bringing friends and family into the activities, and spreading the word about the event.

The event has now been moved from our original date of September 2021 to September 2022 because of the corona virus pandemic and we all hope that nothing further happens to cause issues. The site, which was originally in Ohio, has been moved to Michigan (but as close to Ohio as possible) at the Monroe County Fairgrounds along with field event sites near Lansing and northwest of Lansing. It was available and they have gone out of their way to allow us to do this by allowing us to use the grounds beginning on Labor Day weekend when they are typically closed. We have the facilities, we have a schedule (September 2-14, 2022) and we now have a group to handle all the details. We plan to run all the events possible except for tracking a this national. What we need is support from all CVGRC members, in whatever way possible, to help make sure we do a great job and provide the Golden Retriever world with another fantastic national. We did that in 2003 and that is our aim this time.

We have periodic meetings to go through the various tasks and concerns that need to be handled. Inquire with one of the committee chairs or me if you want to get involved and see where you can help. It will take a community to do this and I look forward to working with all of you.
