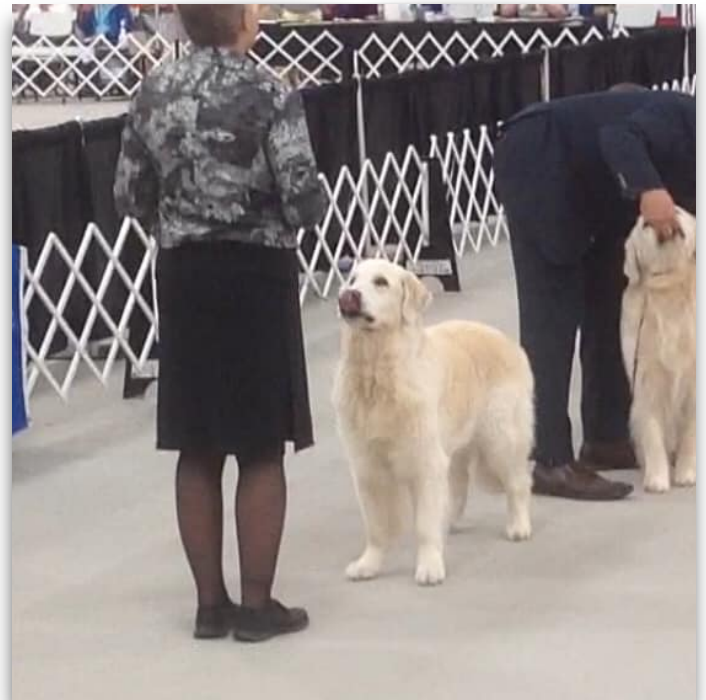

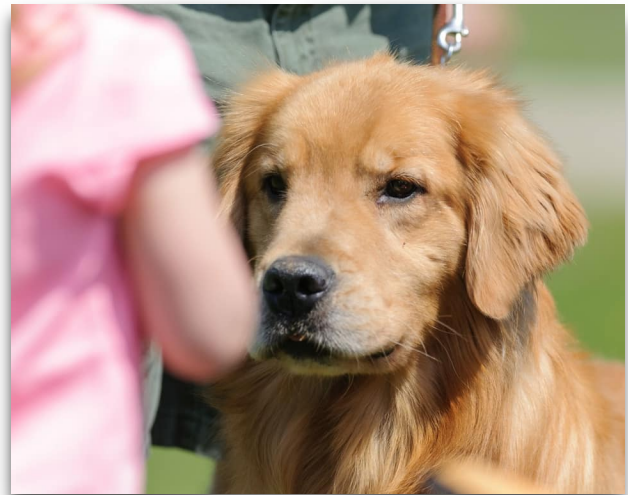

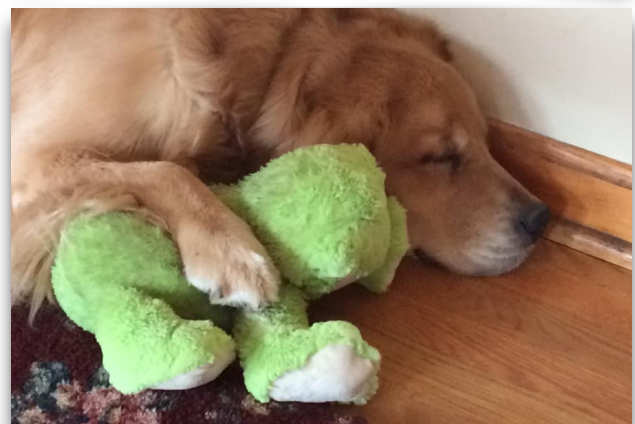


**Misty Meadows Return of Top Gun
