CVGRC General Meeting with Program 1/24/2022

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 by club president Vicki White

In attendance:

Vicki stated that last minutes had been published in the newsletter and asked for approval.

Minutes were approved.

Kathy Koenig (corresponding secretary) had no new information

Treasurers Report: (Tara)

Tara Perby stated that our total membership in 2021 was 69, and there may have been 2 or 3 who joined later in the year and have not been updated. There are 5 honorary members and 32 lifetime members. She has collected \$410 in dues for 2022. So far this year I've received 13 renewals , 6 paying members. Reminder to "Old Timers" to still send in membership renewal forms so that we can have current information. Cappi will set up an online option. Newer members are also welcome to use online option, but please remember to send dues to Tara. (Note: online option captured another 14 renewals). If you have not done so, please complete renewal form and send to Tara OR use online option. We are hoping to keep are records accurate.

Tara also submitted club financial report for 2021 which can be discussed at next Board meeting

Sue Sanvido stated that trophies and ribbons for the Summer Specialty in New Castle, PA had been ordered.

There was a brief discussion about the possibility of having a food truck at the Summer Specialty. Issues include ongoing Covid concerns and the inability to find a food truck willing to come for so few people and potentially no profit. We will continue to investigate other options, including the possibility of ordering and bringing in food.

Vicki said that the AKC has requested a \$50 donation from clubs to support a PAC for ethical dog ownership. She will try to get more information for us.

Rhonda Hovan has finished an article for GR News, Vicki approved, and is sending it in, Look for it in an upcoming issue.

Sue Sanvido is requesting to borrow any 8 ft tables you might have available for a few months. Jan Furtwangler is relocating to Florida soon to be closer to family, so Steve Harmon retrieved a couple 4x8's and sawhorses that had been purchased for storage. Chris Eyerman can cut them. We will need to get them from Harmon's in Akron area up to Chris in North Olmsted. Sue also said we are going to need some storage space, as her basement is quickly filling up. If anyone has any suggestions or leads, please let Sue know. Ideally, this would be not too far from Sue's home in Olmsted Falls (Stearns Rd/480)

The Cincinnati Club has donated \$1500 for trophies at the National. We also have a donation from the Ft Detroit Club. And "Daniel" will be donating all the trophies for Juniors!

Don would like to have an in person meeting sometime the end of February for the National, and is willing to travel to this area for a couple days. Trying to find a central meeting area, which presents challenges with ongoing Covid restrictions. We will remind him to bring his laptop so that we can Zoom meeting. Will update information on website and newsletter if we are able to establish a time and place.

Tara will be looking for some help on the first day of agility (Saturday September 3) at the National, and asked for anyone who might otherwise be there who could help. She got several volunteers, but can always use more. (Same day as 2nd day of Hunt Test). Cappi will add a note in the newsletter and update website.

Marilyn Richards asked about 2021 Awards. Tara and Cappi will update application and post on website and newsletter.

Karen Bodner is still looking for some help with decorations at the National. Will try to define specific needs.

Richard Hardy presented an interesting program about plans for our pets in the event of disability or death. There can be long term needs and/or short term needs.
