Meeting was held at Brunswick Library, Brunswick, Ohio and was called to order at 11:05.

The meeting was held in conjunction the GRCA National 2022 planning committee and chaired by Don Burlett, Chair of National 2022.

National 2022

Don presented a power point presentation which showed the layout of Monroe Cty. Fairgrounds. Detailed slides showed the areas designated for RV's, agility, conformation, grooming, vendors, agility and rally/obedience as well as parking, showers and restrooms.

The stock area will be graded//rolled on Friday in preparation for agility

Agility tailgate will be held on Friday night

Obedience/CCA will be on the 5th.

If going to field trial can leave RVs at Monroe till Monday 4 H building will be available for 10 days for Hospitality

Columbus has offered to do morning hospitality 1 day No crating behind bleachers in stock area.

Gating concerns with agility and lay out of agility (rings and crating)

On line raffles (gas card did not go well) and donations/sponsorship for trophies for trophies, especially in agility.

Vendor set up and layout of "Vendor Village"

Much discussion followed on the above topics including hospitality. Next meeting will be 5/21 at Monroe Fairgrounds

CVGRC Status of CVGRC/GPGRC Specialty was discussed. Need for volunteers and donations for trophies also addressed.

Heart clinic will be held at the Madison shows in July Will be meeting in the next few weeks to finish working on table decorations for the National.

Meeting adjourned at 1:15pm
