If you do so and if entry limits are reached, your entry (with fees) will be returned. If you enter Advanced B and Excellent B as your classes, and have not indicated RAE Entry on the Rally entry form, your entry will be accepted for the class that has not filled, and your entry fee for the class that has filled will be returned.

When entering Rally Advanced B, Excellent B and Masters for RACH Qualifying scores, indicate on the Rally entry form **RACH entry** if you want to enter the trial only if you can get into Advanced B, Excellent B and Master. If you do so and if entry limits are reached, your entry (with fees) will be returned. If you enter Advanced B, Excellent B and Master as your classes, and have not indicated RACH Entry on the Rally entry form, your entry will be accepted for the class(es) that have not filled, and your entry fee for the class(es) that have filled will be returned.

The Trial Secretary will maintain a wait list for RAE and RACH entries once class limits have been reached. Should any entries be withdrawn prior to the trial closing thus creating an opening, exhibitor(s) will be notified.

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows/Registration and Discipline" and, if this entry is for an obedience trial and/or agility trial, the "Obedience Regulations", and/or the "Agility Trial Regulations", have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under the "AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines". I (we) agree that the club holding this show, obedience trial and/or agility trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show, obedience trial or agility trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or agility trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
- The following categories or dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in the show's premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. RALLY TRIAL REGULATIONS

ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE TRIAL SECRETARY'S OFFICE, at 6:00 PM , Wednesday, January 18, 2023 after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled, or substituted. Make check payable to **Medina Kennel Club**. Canadian exhibitors must have fees payable in US Funds
RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$35 to the amount of each returned check.

ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. **OVERNIGHT deliveries** requiring **NO** signature only. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

A RECORDING FEE OF \$.50 is to be collected **on the first entry only for each dog, each day. An Event Service fee of \$3.00** will be required for each regular class each dog is entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show Obedience Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competing by action of the Trial Committee.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE NO MORE THAN 60 MIN PRIOR to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. All dogs present must be held on leash in hand except when being judged.

NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE RETURNED if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the management.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT carefully, the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

NO REFUND ON DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY, their agents and employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRIES and a judging program will be made as soon as possible after entries close. Should such acknowledgment not be received within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary (440) 759.4794.

BITCHES WHO COME IN SEASON after the closing date may have their entry fees refunded less \$5.00 per entry upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial.

INJURED DOGS, which cannot compete due to an injury, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$5.00 (per trial), upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary no later than 8:00 AM on the day of the trial.

WHEN THE SAME DOG IS ENTERED in more than one class, only the highest score will be used for the top awards in Trial or top awards of a breed.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show giving club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED at the Trial or they become the property of the Medina Kennel Club, none will be mailed.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring. All handlers are asked to clean up after their own dog.

HEALTH Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Note: Medina Kennel Club may cancel this event due to extreme weather conditions.

*** DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE ***

From I-76 – Take Rt 3 (Wooster Pike) north about 5 miles to 162, where road will "T" at a round-about at Wooster Pike. Take 2nd exit off round-about onto Wooster Pike. and proceed approximately ½ mile to light at Rt.162 – take RIGHT on Rt. 162. 2nd intersection on Rt. 162 is Lake Rd– 4 way stop – take Left. MKC building is approximately 1 mile south on the right.

From I-71 – Exit at Rt 18 and go west on Rt 18 approximately 1 mile – turn left onto River Styx Road (light) and go approximately 2.5 miles to Rt 162 (Sharon Copley Rd- stop sign) turn right and go approximately 3 miles – road will "T" at Wooster Pike – turn left and proceed approximately ½ mile to light at Rt.162 – take RIGHT on Rt. 162. 2nd intersection on Rt. 162 is Lake Rd– 4 way stop – take Left. MKC building is approximately 1 mile south on the right.
