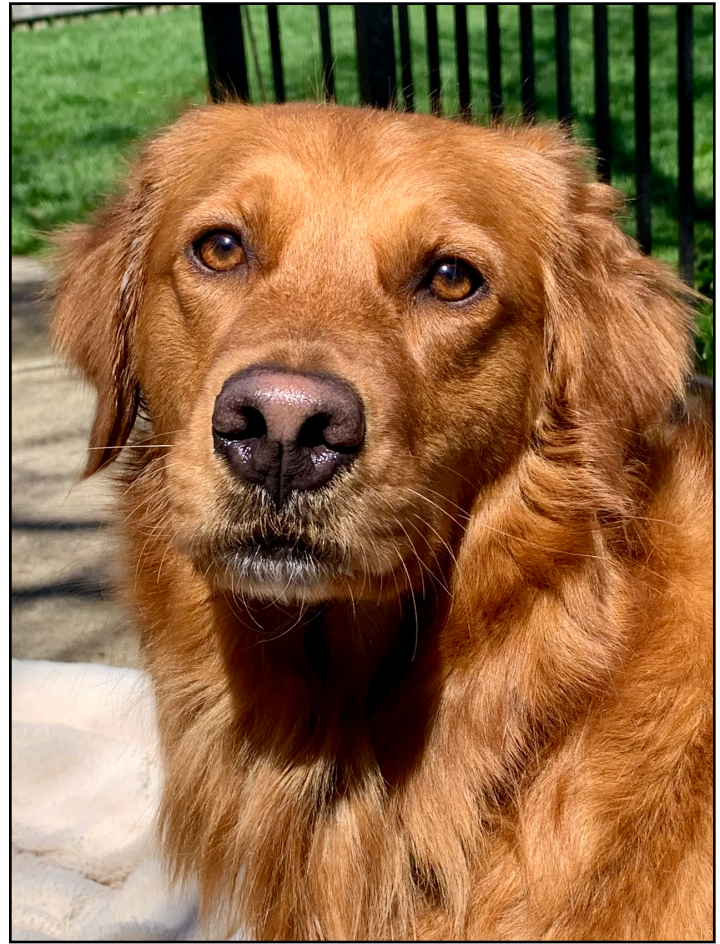

AKC Retriever Basic Hunt Test Judge's Seminar and Advanced Hunt Test Judge's Seminar

Basic Seminar: Friday, May 5, 2023

Advanced Seminar: Saturday/Sunday, May 6-7

Location: Locke Township Hall 3805 Bell Oak Rd, Williamston, MI

The **Basic Seminar** is one day of instruction on the AKC Hunting Retriever program. The event is for individuals with an interest in becoming an AKC Hunt Test Judge and/or handlers who wish to learn more about the AKC Hunt Test for Retrievers, and eligible breeds.

The **Advanced Seminar** has been designed for Judges that have attended the basic one day AKC Hunting Test Seminar and have attained some judging experience through apprenticeships and/or actual judging. This seminar reinforces regulations, guidelines and test requirements and covers what to expect when you are asked to judge. One half day is spent in the classroom, a day and a half in the field developing and running tests at three levels. We usually run three dogs at each level, Junior, Senior, Master.

Dogs will not be allowed in the seminar building. Please leave your dogs at home for the basic seminar or make provisions for their safekeeping in your vehicle. Registration fees include seminar, all material, continental breakfast and lunch.
