WC/WCX Practice Test

Lynn Property (1471 Fixler Rd, Wadsworth, OH)

This will be a chance to do a run thru of a WC/WCX test. It is not designed to teach a dog how to do the tests, but training is allowed. In addition, you can get coaching and suggestions for handling.

We will use ducks, but no flyers. Everyone physically able should bring a white shirt and be prepared to take a turn working in the field. Bring a chair, water, food, etc.

This is open to CVGRC members AND non-members, so spread the word. Registration will be limited to 10 WC and 10 WCX dogs. Pre-registration is required to ensure that we have enough ducks.
